

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR CAMPERS:

**Opening times:** The camping site is open from 12 pm on Wednesday 21 August 2019 through 2 pm on Sunday 25 August.

Please observe the **curfew** between 10 pm and 6 am: Keep the noise down!

There is no limitation on drinks.

If you notice a fire, please inform security or go to the info point.

There are several first aiders on site. Please refer to the site map for their locations. If there is an emergency and you are unable to find a first aider, please ask a member of security. A list of local **out-of-hours pharmacies** can be obtained from the Info Point.

Go to our **Info Point** for: travel information, weather forecasts, maps, and lost & found. You can use the lockers located here to store your valuables. Charging stations for your mobile devices are available on the campsite.

**Taking care of footpaths, festivals grounds and facilities.** Footpaths, festival grounds and facilities on the camping site must be kept clean and treated with care. This includes toilets, showers and washing facilities. For reasons of hygiene, sewage must be disposed of into the drains provided. It is prohibited to urinate anywhere on the site, except the public toilets. It is prohibited to pollute the natural waters, to damage trees and groves on the camping site or in the car park and adjacent woods. Any of these activities will be recorded as vandalism and the perpetrators will be prosecuted.

If you are the victim of damage, theft, etc. please go to the Info point. They can give you the assistance you need.

**CAUTION:** Please look after your valuables. Take only the valuables you really need. Your tent, bag nor car are safe storage places. There will be lockers available so you won't have to carry your valuables around all weekend.

**Official filming and photography** will take place throughout the festival. Video recordings and photographs may be reproduced and distributed for media coverage and documentation in print, DVD, TV, and online (e.g. homepage, social networks, etc.). By entering the festival or camping site, **visitors consent** to their likeness and voice to be included on film and photographs and to their use in any of the outlined ways without compensation and without restrictions in terms of time, space or content.

**Exploitation of video and sound recordings.** Visitors irrevocably consent to the appearance of their likeness and voice in photographs, live broadcast, video and sound recordings made or commissioned by the organiser or third parties in connection to the event/ concert, as well as their subsequent exploitation in all current and future media (especially sound or video storage media as well as digital forms of dissemination, e.g. via the internet) without claim to compensation.

Barbecues are allowed, except between 10 pm and 8 am. The use of **liquid barbecue lighters**, alcohol, fuel and other flammable liquids is strictly prohibited. For safety reasons, open fires are

prohibited anywhere on the festival and the camping site. Smoking is prohibited in wooded areas. Barbecues are allowed both with disposable barbecues as well as tripod barbecues.

**Loudhailers, vuvuzelas, and similar items**, are not allowed on the festival site. Bengal fires and other fireworks are strictly prohibited and anyone found in possession or using them will be penalised. (Expulsion from the event site for a limited time).

**Pets are not allowed on site.** It is not allowed to bring animals and pets onto the event and camping site. This includes guide dogs and other assistance animals.

**Crowd surfing.** Crowd surfing, mosh pits, circle pits, wall of death, as well as the use of fireworks (e.g. Bengal fires) and other activities that put the health of other visitors at risk are strictly prohibited and anyone violating this rule will be excluded from the event.

**Organiser's liability in case of theft, etc. / lockers.** The organiser is not liable for damage or loss incurred through burglary, theft, fire, natural events and other occurrences. The limitations in number I 1 (liability of the organiser) apply. Valuables can be left in the lockers in the left luggage area. The organiser is not responsible for items left in lockers.

**Damage to health, incl. hearing damage.** The organiser is not liable for damage to health and hearing unless the organiser or his agents are shown to have acted intentionally or negligently, or a legal duty to implement and maintain safety was culpably neglected. Visitors should keep a safe distance from speakers. Barriers installed around the site must be respected. The use of ear plugs is strongly recommended, especially near the stages.

**Lost tickets and/or wristbands cannot be replaced.**

**Visitors are liable for culpably caused damage.**

**The minimum age for visitors is 18 years.**

The distribution of flyers and other promotional materials on the festival and camping site is not allowed. The advertising value and cleaning costs for illegally distributed materials will be charged to the originator.

Please be aware that **Racists are not allowed!** We will take immediate and decisive action against any racial, sexual, homophobic and other harassment. Offenders will be expelled from the event site. Banned symbols and neo-nazi music of any kind are strictly prohibited on the event site!
